2 PARKING IN GUNPIT ROAD CAR PARK

The Chairman proposed that the Parish Council makes a formal request to Tandridge District Council to remove time restrictions for parking in Gunpit Road Car Park. The current arrangements are placing an unnecessary burden on traders in the village. It is envisaged that although there may be less spaces for shoppers, the introduction of time limited parking in the High Street will address this issue.
