1 LONG TERM ASSETS

COMMUNITY ASSETS including Parish Property:-

The Community Centre was purchased during 1998/99. The cost to the Parish Council of purchase and refurbishment to date is £87,863. The Jennings Hall was purchased from the District Council in 2017/18 for a sum of £5,000.

In addition, the Parish owns Lingfield War Memorial, Gunpit Pond, planters, seats, office equipment and sundry other items. Planters, seats, field shelter, office equipment and sundry items. The value is the purchase cost or valuation is unknown.

Other community assets without insurance value are shown as £1.

The 2009 assets value was restated to reflect historic costs.
