

# Lingfield Byways Walks


## Walk 2

### Crowhurst to Ardenrun via Jenner's Field/Paris Farm

Route Distance 4.05 miles  
Estimated time 1 hr 40 mins

Leave Lingfield and Dormansland Community Centre by the side gate and turn right to go along the twitten. On reaching St Peter and St Paul Churchyard, keep left and then descend two flights of steps with the Lingfield Community-Partnered Library on your left. Cross Vicarage Road and ascend the flight of steps onto the footpath on the other side of the road. At the end of this enclosed path, go through the kissing gate on your left into Jenner's Field. Go around to the right of the playground and cross Jenner's Field diagonally to the point where the gravelled footpath crosses through the hedge line. Cross over the gravelled path into

Bloomers Field and continue with another hedgerow to your left. Just before you reach the copse of trees, go left through the gap in the hedge and turn right onto the footpath that descends through the copse. On reaching the gravelled path at the bottom of Bloomer's Field turn left and go through the kissing gate to Coldharbour. Now stay on this tarmac drive until you reach Lingfield Common Road, where you turn right.

When you reach the Lingfield Common Road cross-roads; turn left and cross the road into Crowhurst Road. Walk in single file along Crowhurst Road, past all the bungalows until the road bears round to your right. You will find a footpath sign leading into woodland at the apex of this bend. Turn left onto the footpath, which can be muddy in winter, but is always passable. Stay on this footpath until you reach the tarmac drive at Ardenrun where you turn left. Now look for a stile with a footpath sign in the hedge on your left. Go over the stile and turn left, and straight ahead to the next stile then walk diagonally across the next field until you find the next stile. Cross over this stile and turn immediately right until you reach a gap in the hedge, which you pass through, bearing left as you do so. Now walk ahead until you reach a five bar gate and go through it onto a concrete bridge to cross Ray Brook. Go through the second gate and follow the footpath until the T junction where you turn left. This path takes you around to the left of Sugham Farm.

Continue past the private driveway on the footpath which turns first left and then right.

When you reach Lingfield Common Road, cross over, turn left and then immediately right onto a tarmac drive which leads to Coldharbour. On reaching the Y junction, bear right with a high fence appearing on your right. Go straight on, pass through the kissing gate into a field and then through another kissing gate onto a tarmac drive, where you turn left. Walk past Paris Farm, which is on your left and then take the footpath to the left of Stoneacre. Just before the next kissing gate, turn left onto a path which leads via a series of kissing gates into Centenary Field, which is part of the Lingfield Nature Reserves. Go straight ahead and take the gravelled path which goes past the field shelter. Turn right and walk through Jenner's Field to the field gate exit at the corner of Vicarage Road. Turn left; cross the road towards Lingfield Primary School and walk downhill until you reach a flight of brick steps towards the bottom of the hill on your right. Ascend the steps and as you continue towards the second flight of steps you will pass Lingfield Community-Partnered Library this time on your right. Ascend the second flight of steps and bear right through St Peter and St Paul churchyard. This footpath becomes a twitten, which eventually leads you back to the Lingfield and Dormansland Community Centre.
